Regatta, as expected, gets very quiet during the winter. The biggest challenge is working with the other Bay clubs and coordinating calendars. What stands out this year is a growing interest in onedesign racing. There are active and growing fleets of C&C 25's and Flying Scots. If you're asking yourself: isn't one-design racing the same as what the Narrasketucks, Opti's, 420's and Vanguards have been doing for years? The answer is yes. The difference is the C&C's intersect our BYC Corinthian fleet, and the 'Scots' intersect our membership (Flying Scots are used in the frostbite fleet and the adult sailing program). So now the

Regatta schedule needs to consider these as well when scheduling events.

For the non-sailor, a one design fleet is where the boats racing are generally the same boat. There is usually a class or fleet definition that imposes limitations on equipment, etc. The intent of these definitions is to keep the boats similar in speed so the competition is focused on the skill of the crew. Race management is easier because the first to finish gets first place, second- second place, etc.

Compare this to the BYC Corinthian fleet where the boats vary in size and equipment. This fleet operates under the Performance Handicap Rating Formula (PHRF) system. The PHRF (usually pronounced 'perf') has a formula to determine a boat's base handicap (roughly translated to seconds per mile allowances). Since the BYC uses a time on distance system to calculate a winner in the PHRF fleet, a boat's handicap, elapsed racing time, and race course distance are used to calculate a corrected time. The shortest corrected time is the winner. With this type of system, it is possible for the last boat to finish to win the race. While PHRF adds complexity to scoring, it is an attempt to allow different types of boats to compete fairly. While crew skill is always important, boat equipment and race conditions play a significant role in a boat's performance. Handicaps can be adjusted to account for the vagaries, but PHRF will always be an attempt at making it fair for different boats to compete. The less the difference in two boats' handicap number - the fairer the approximation.

Now is a good time to get the kids enrolled in a boating safety class. These courses are available for ages 10 and up. If you are a boating family or your kids pal around with boaters, it is a worthwhile course to learn the basics. These courses are usually taught by the Coast Guard Auxiliary or the US Power Squadron at a nominal cost. I've seen them offered as a full day course or spread over several days. Check your local school districts Adult Education program - many districts
