

SUFFOLK COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH REQUIREMENT:

NO FOOD OR DRINK ON POOL DECK OTHER THAN WATER

The following are just a few reminders to help make the season run smoothly. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Children are <u>not</u> permitted upstairs in the Clubhouse.
- 2. All Members <u>must</u> sign in on the pool deck. Members <u>must</u> also sign in their guests by name.
- 3. \$5.00 pool guest fee is <u>required</u> of all guests entering the pool deck whether they swim or not.
- Adults and children must lock bicycles on bike rack. They cannot be left randomly on club grounds.
- Hard balls (lacrosse balls, baseballs, softballs, etc) are not permitted on the grounds of the BYC. They could inflict injury or damage.
- 6. Please adhere to House and Guest rules on p. 39 in the B.Y.C. yearbook.
- 7. Please place playground toys/balls back in the bin after use.
- 8. Adult supervision is required in playground area.
- 9. Ice is for member use only and members must use ice on club premises.
- 10. Please refrain from parking and/or idling by the no parking signs near the snack bar.
