VENUE: The venue will be off the Babylon Yacht Club in the general area of Babylon and West Islip, NY.

All classes/crews should be prepared to stay on the water thru late afternoon.

RULES: This event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

ELIGIBILITY: This is an invitational event.

ENTRIES: Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form to registering online at www.regattanetwork.com/event/12392 and must check in at the Registration Desk between 0830-1000 on the Babylon Yacht Club Porch. Competitors may also enter by delivering a completed entry form to the Registration Desk between 0830-1000 on the Babylon Yacht Club Porch.

RULES: The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

- Conflicts between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions will be resolved in favor of the Sailing Instructions. This changes rule 63.7.
- All classes must consist of 3 boats each to be considered a class, except for PHRF. Other boats will sail in the Handicap Class.
- Another division may be added or subtracted depending on the number of participating boats.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: 0930 on the BYC Porch.

SAFETY: One-Design competitors shall wear a properly fastened US Coast Guard approved Personal Floatation Device (PFD), inherently buoyant, (i.e. not inflatable) while afloat.

SCORING: The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the racing rules, will apply, except that each yacht's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. There will be no throw outs.

COURSES: One Design courses will be triangles, trapezoids, windward/leewards or a combination thereof. PHRF courses will be a combination of government mark & inflatable marks.

BERTHING: Available at the BYC Dock or Launch areas on a first-come-first-served basis. Slips reserved for Regatta, Patrol and RC will be marked.

MISC: Prepackaged lunches will be available for a nominal fee in the main clubhouse during registration. T-shirts designed for the event will also be on sale.

PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded after races in the BYC Clubhouse.
